- Since If is an island, it can only be reached by boat, but that only adds to the fun!
- The Château d'If is home to some 400 years of graffiti carved by prisoners, guards and soldiers.
- As part of the Calanques National Park, If is also home to many protected species.

Built in 1529 as a fortress on the island of If, it became a prison in 1541 and has confined some of the most famous prisoners in French history, including the Count of Mirabeau and the legendary Count of Monte Cristo.

At the heart of the Calanques National Park, the Château d'If is an extraordinary location for your clients to appreciate unique views across the harbour of Marseille!

### ***DID YOU KNOW...?***

The first time Francis I set foot on If was to marvel at an Indian rhinoceros that had not been seen in Europe since the 3<sup>rd</sup> century AD.
